

# Whipping Cream

## Ingredients

Cream, carrageenan, cellulose gum, cellulose gel

## Description

Whipping Cream is manufactured from fresh milk of bovine origin using a centrifugal separation process. Gums are added to facilitate whipping and the blended product is pasteurized and packaged for use.

## Properties

Vitalus Nutrition Whipping Cream is characterized by a clean creamy taste and a light milky aroma. The addition of carrageen and cellulose gums produces a firm whipped texture while minimizing separation of the whipping cream during use.

## Applications

Our Whipping Cream is a superior finished product that is suitable for a wide range of applications, largely in desserts, bakery and dairy applications.

## Certifications

## Continuing Product Guarantee

Each and every article contained in each shipment of Whipping Cream (1450200) is hereby guaranteed to:

## Lot Coding

The product lot is generated based on the date the product is pasteurized and expressed in the format: ddmmyy (e.g. 300909 for 30 September 2009).

## Packaging

Whipping Cream is packaged in 1,000 kg totes with polyethylene liners.

## Storage Conditions

Store in the original tote at temperatures of 0-4°C (32-39°F). Extended storage outside the conditions specified above may impact product quality and functionality.

## Shelf Life

In the original sealed packaging, Whipping Cream has a shelf life of at least 18 days.

## Legislation

Whipping Cream is food grade and is manufactured under food grade conditions, and complies with all FDA food regulations.

Current Canadian legislation prohibits the use of bovine growth hormones in dairy cattle, therefore Whipping Cream is free for recombinant bovine somatotrophic hormones (rbST/bST) and recombinant bovine growth hormones (rbGH/bGH).

In addition, the use of antibiotics in maintaining the health of dairy cows is strictly monitored. Milk is tested both at the farms and at the dairy processing plants to ensure milk is free from antibiotic residues.

Whipping Cream does not contain genetically modified organisms (GMOs) or GMO-derived products as ingredients.

Melamine is not used as an ingredient, processing aid, or additive, or in anyway associated with the production process.

This ingredient complies with EU and Codex requirements for food production and uses only ingredients and processing aids suited for food production.
